- (b) To initiate studies of various aspects of research and other scholarly activities with the intent of improving the climate for these activities at the university and articulating faculty vision on research issues
- (c) To become familiar with the functions of the Office of Research and provide feedback to the Vice Provost of Research when requested.
- (d) To assist the Faculty Senate by investigating issues brought to it relating to research.
- (e) To provide feedback to the Research Administration Advisory Group when the opinions of a broad representation of faculty on researchrelated issues are needed.
- (f) To prepare a brief, written report of the committee's activities at the end of each academic year and to submit copies of this report to the president of the university, the provost, the vice provost of research, and the Faculty Senate.


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



 - Committee voted no objection to joining, but noted weak faculty support.


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
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Role of the Faculty Senate in Committees that report directly to the Office of Research
